

Fern area

- Add one more Danae (left side of original plantings)
- Plant a groundcover on the flat part behind the wall
We suggest an evergreen spreading groundcover with some sort of bloom
 - Veronica - Georgia blue or wooly blue (blue green foliage) or
 - St. John's wort??
- Plant additional varieties of ferns to the right of existing ferns (cinnamon, autumn, maidenhair, sensitive, ostrich) planted based on conditional needs of the plants
- Move some Cherokee sedge from the raingarden to the edge of the road to control runoff
- Possibly plant some arum to the left of the dry bed to control erosion and offer winter interest
- Possibly add evening primrose / sundrops behind the veronica to add color in the fall

Rock Garden

- Add a drift of burning bushes up on the bank above the rock garden area (to the right of the ugly redbud)
- Add more varieties of sedum to the cracks of the rock garden (low-growers toward the bottom and higher plants toward the back (autumn joy)
- Possibly add some Rudbekia (Black or green-eyed Susans) and Monarda (red or purple Bee Balm) to the slope to the left of and below the burning bushes to add summer color
