
The ERT is comprised of your neighbors who have volunteered to cover 20 areas in our neighborhood. The ERT members are ready to respond to immediate needs in the aftermath of an emergency event. When emergency services like police, fire, first responders or EMS are not readily available, due to priority being given to other areas, the ERT may be able to help. Each family should prepare a ready kit to provide for your family for up to 3 days. The list of items that you could include is printed on your Ready Kit bag. (provided by the Welcoming Committee to each new resident) Please contact a member of the ERT if you have questions.

The ERT team is not outfitted with helmets, reflective harnesses and ID tags. All three cameras are now operational.


In case of emergency, you should first dial 911.




The neighborhood is divided into 20 area sectors with an ERT area captain assigned to each sector. That person will be your contact for assistance or reporting. This map and the list of area captains can be found on the Lakemoor Hils website and on the Lakemoor Hills Facebook page. Use this map to determine in which sector you reside.




The 3 new camera systems approved by the HOA in January are in place, operable and reporting directly to the KPD and Knox Co. Sheriff's office. The locations are depicted in the graphic. These cameras record license tags of vehicles passing the 3 locations. If you have an incident, dial 911 to report. Describe the incident and inform the authorities of the camera system. The police can search by time of incident and partial license plate, so be specific about capturing that information. Also follow up with your area captain to make them aware of the incident.




The Alcoa Hwy Beautification Council is currently conducting surveys to identify any properties adjacent to our neighborhood along the highway that are experiencing change of ownership, change of use or change of zoning. This information will be shared with the neighborhood if any changes seem to negatively impact our area.

Recently there was a rework of Montlake at the intersection of the new bridge road. This work will allow the Montlake and the Martha Washington Heights bridges to open by the end of November. Once that occurs, we will be able to go north from Lakemoor Hills without taking a left onto Alcoa.


The contractor has begun replacing the soil in the roundabouts to prepare for the landscape installation. This is much ahead of schedule.




Neighborhood Tree lighting will be Saturday, Dec. 5 at 5 PM. All are welcome to come decorate at 3:30 PM.
