Planting guidelines:

- Plants should be dug during September or October and planted in potting soil and pots
 that are appropriately sized for the plant (approx. 4" pots for smaller perennials; quart
 pots for larger perennials; 1-3 gallon pots for small shrubs or trees). Please label your
 plants (your name and plant's common name) with a popsicle stick, sticky label or duct
 tape and permanent marker. Bulbs should be put in plastic zip-lock bags and labeled
 similarly. Be sure to keep your potted plants watered during dry periods.
- It is important that we receive your plants no later than October 21st as we will be organizing, pricing, and setting up the sale in the garden on the 22nd. You may drop them off at the Thomforde home: 3616 Circle Lake Ln. or someone will call you and arrange a time to pick them up if you indicated that on the previous form.

A few extra goodies for contributors:

- Every neighbor who contributes plants or makes a donation will have a chance to win one of our fabulous "gate prizes".
